Restore Ecological Processes & Habitats


-Bring back stream flow, reduce erosion, rebuild soils
-Respond to fire & flooding patterns

Restore Food Chains for Pollinators


-Return nectar- & fruit-bearing plants-Protect & enhance roosts, stopovers, corridors

-Build community by guiding employees, citizen scientists, funders in restoring ecosystem services that promote food security, ecosystem jobs, and community capacity-building




Slow the water, retain sediment, allow recovery












2. Placement at crossovers maintains natural erosion and deposition patterns.























